## Workshop on "Developmentally Supportive Care in the NICU" Organised by the Department of Neonatology




The Department of Neonatology in association with the Developmentally Supportive Care (DSC) Foundation for Newborn and Children (India) and the Indian Association of Paediatrics, North Arcot Branch organised a workshop on “DSC in Premies and Neuroprotection in the Neonatal ICU, Strategies for Neonatal Integrative Developmental Care” on September 22nd and 23rd 2023.

The workshop was inaugurated by Dr. Solomon Sathishkumar, Principal, Mrs. Alice Sony, Nursing Superintendent with Rev Rajesh Charles and Dr. Anil Kuruvilla from Neonatology Department also in attendance. Dr Nisha Kalaiarasan, Secretary, IAP North Arcot, congratulated the department for organising the workshop addressing an important aspect in the care of preterm neonates that could have a significant impact on each child’s growth and development. This was followed by the release of the 4th edition of the workbook on “DSC in Premies and Neuroprotection in the NICU”.

Faculty for the workshop were Dr. Amitava Sengupta, Lead Faculty and Director of Neonatology and Paediatrics, Paras Hospital, Gurgaon, Dr. Pradeep Kumar Debata, Professor, VMMC & Safdarjung Hospital, New Delhi, Dr. S P Senthil Kumar, Lead Consultant, Natus Women & Children’s Hospital, Bengaluru, and Mrs. Hima J B, Occupational Therapy Tutor, Neonatology Department. The objectives of this programme was to:


- Sensitize the participants to understand the principles of learning

## Obituaries



**Dr. G.M. Jeyabalan** (MBBS batch of 1959-60) passed away on 24th October 2023. He was born on 14 October 1942. He joined for his MBBS course at Christian Medical College, Vellore in the year 1959. Soon after his internship, joined St Luke's Leprosarium, Peikulam, in the Tuticorin district of Tamilnadu to fulfil his service obligation. After seeing firsthand, the plight of the leprosy patients in this area, he got his special leprosy training in CMC & Karigiri and continued to serve in the same mission hospital from 1967 till his retirement in 2007 for a total of 40 years.

He was awarded the 25 Years Meritorious Service award in the year 1996. He was also the recipient of the prestigious Paul Harrison award in 2002 in recognition of his dedicated services to the field of Leprosy in a rural mission hospital.

He pioneered the cause of early detection and treatment of leprosy in the area through field visits, screening of family members, health education and rehabilitation of patients. He also started a home for abandoned children of leprosy afflicted patients, which provided shelter, food and education to those helpless children. He was deeply dedicated to his patients, leaving home as early as 5 am on most days and returning late at nights. He is survived by his wife Dr. Chandra Jeyabalan and 3 daughters, Dr. Pushpa Jeyabalan (MBBS batch of 1989), Dr. Salome Jeyabalan (MBBS batch of 1995) and Dr. Susan Jeyabalan (PG alumnus, Psychiatry) and 3 grandchildren.
