CMC Vellore Launches Consultation 2025 and the Blue-Sky Thinking Group (BSTG)



Insights from Former Directors and Global Leaders Illuminate the Path Forward

Christian Medical College (CMC) Vellore, a vessel of healing and hope, grounded in compassionate care and transformative education, conducts consultation every 6 to 10 years which are sacred pauses in the institutional rhythm, moments to reflect deeply on our mission and reimagine health care for the future. CMC Vellore began its **Consultation 2025** journey in September 2024; this marks the **sixth consultation** since 1980, with the last held in 2016.

Given the vast and intricate nature of CMC Vellore's service, Consultation 2025 spans 18 domains, including Theology, Faith & Action and Spiritual Nurture; Education; Patient Care; Research; General Services & Infrastructure; Human Resource; External Engagement & Community Impact; Information Technology; Healthcare Technology; Governance & Administrative Structures; Finance; Policy Engagement; Communications; Community Building; Quality & Safety; Ethics; Legal Issues and Management; Innovations – From Development to Societal Impact / Industrial Collaboration; Chittoor Campus. Faculty, staff and students across generations and disciplines are actively engaging in these focused and deliberate conversations.

The Consultation Team has meaningfully engaged over 5,000 CMC Vellore staff and students through nearly 100 interactive sessions—building awareness, fostering dialogue, and driving meaningful participation across the institution. In addition, the consultation process has actively captured diverse perspectives through comprehensive online surveys—gathering valuable feedback from CMC Vellore staff, students, departments, alumni, partners, and the wider Christian mission network.

On 15th March 2025, a reflective retreat and worskhop for domain conveners and co-conveners, led by Dr. M.C. Mathew, focused on "Heritage and Its Significance." It explored CMC's "legacy", "innovations in healthcare", and "key transitions". The event also encouraged personal reflection and alignment with CMC's mission, fostering renewed commitment and community spirit.

Recognising the need for bold, imaginative thinking in today's rapidly shifting landscape, CMC Vellore initiated the **Blue Sky Thinking Group (BSTG)**—a vibrant space for open, cross-disciplinary dialogue. BSTG is bringing together diverse voices from India and around the world, spanning fields such as Education, Public Health, Theology, Spirituality, and Information Technology. It is a call to dream beyond boundaries, rooted in CMC Vellore's enduring commitment to healing, service, and Christ-centered values.

A meeting of **former Directors** was held on the morning of **7**th **June 2025**. with Dr. V.I. Mathan, Dr. Joyce Ponnaiya, Dr. George Chandy, Dr. Suranjan Bhattacharjee, Dr. Sunil Chandy and Dr. J.V. Peter whose wisdom illuminated both external challenges and internal complexities—such as the cultural impact of expansion and the stewardship of a growing institution. A recurring theme was CMC Vellore's unwavering mission: to deliver **affordable**, **compassionate healthcare to the underserved**, while staying true to its spiritual core.

The evening featured the inaugural BSTG webinar, attended by nearly 70 national and international leaders. Following the opening remarks by Ms. Anuvinda Varkey, Chairperson of the CMC Vellore Association, presentations were delivered by Dr. Vikram Mathews, Director of CMC Vellore; Dr. Solomon Sathishkumar, Principal; Dr. Vinitha Ravindran, Dean of the College of Nursing; Dr. Rajesh I., Medical Superintendent; Mrs. Alice Sony, Nursing Superintendent; Dr. Jachin Velavan, Associate Director – Missions; and Dr. Jacob John, Additional Vice Principal – Research. These presentations provided a candid overview of the institution's current initiatives and challenges. The webinar was moderated by Dr. John C. Oommen and Dr. Vijay Aruldas, and the discussions sparked thoughtful reflections, encouraging participants to remain engaged through written feedback and personal conversations.

The Consultation 2025 Committee is led by Dr. Thomas S Ram as Chairperson, with Dr. D.J. Christopher, Dr. Nihal Thomas, Dr. Vinitha Ravindran, and Dr. Vinay Oommen serving as Core Committee members. Dr. John C. Oommen and Dr. Vijay Aruldas serve as Advisors and Conveners of the Blue Sky Thinking Group (BSTG).

The year-long preparatory process will culminate in a week-long **Consultation Conclave** scheduled from 21st to 26th September 2025. This Conclave will serve as a platform to synthesize and present the outcomes of internal and external deliberations conducted throughout the year to the CMC Vellore Council. The proceedings will guide the direction of the institution and contribute to the formulation of a comprehensive strategic plan for the forthcoming decade.

Consultation 2025 is not just a forum—it's a movement. It is inspiring fresh perspectives, challenging assumptions, and nurturing a shared vision for a future where CMC Vellore continues to be the Salt and the Light in the world—serving excellence, humility, and hope in the Spirit of Christ.
