CMC Vellore Virology Department Wins State Recognition for HIV-1 Viral Load Testing



The Department of Virology at Christian Medical College Vellore has been awarded First Place as the Best Performing HIV-1 Viral Load Testing Laboratory in Tamil Nadu for the Financial Year 2024–2025 by the Tamil Nadu State AIDS Control Society (TANSACS). The award was presented during the World AIDS Day celebrations held in Chennai.

This recognition highlights the laboratory's outstanding performance under the National AIDS Control Programme (NACP), evaluated on key quality indicators including optimal test utilisation, minimal rejection and invalid rates, timely reporting of results, and consistent data entry into the national HIV database.

A pioneer in HIV diagnostics for nearly four decades, Retrovirology Laboratory initiated HIV testing in 1986 as a National Reference Center under the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR). It subsequently introduced CD4 testing in 1990 and HIV-1 viral load testing in 1999. At present, the laboratory performs approximately 1,500 CD4 tests and 1,000 HIV-1 viral load tests annually for people living with HIV receiving care at CMC.

Designated as a National HIV Reference Laboratory (NRL) by the National AIDS Control Organization (NACO) in 2001, CMC has played a vital mentoring role for State Reference Laboratories in Kerala and Lakshadweep, culminating in all five mentored laboratories achieving ISO 15189 accreditation in 2016.

With the expansion of HIV-1 viral load testing under the NACP, CMC became one of 64 authorized laboratories nationwide. Testing volumes increased substantially from about 1,200 tests annually in 2019 to approximately 24,000 tests annually since 2023, following linkage with eight ART centres across Tamil Nadu, supported by TANSACS.

As an accredited Proficiency Testing Laboratory, CMC has also contributed significantly to strengthening the national HIV-1 viral load testing network—an initiative acknowledged by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India. The full range of HIV diagnostic services at CMC, including HIV-1 drug resistance testing, is accredited under ISO 15189:2023.

The award was received by the laboratory team from the Honourable Minister for Health and Family Welfare, Government of Tamil Nadu, Thiru M. Subramanian, on 12 December 2025. The department acknowledges the continued support of NACO, TANSACS, the Departments of Infectious Diseases and Medicine at CMC, and the CMC administration.
