ATS–ICS MECOR 2026 Hosted at CMC Vellore



The ATS–ICS MECOR 2026 programme was successfully conducted at the CMC Vellore, College Campus from 2nd to 6th February 2026. The MECOR (Methods in Epidemiologic, Clinical and Operations Research) India programme is an initiative of the American Thoracic Society (ATS) in collaboration with the Indian Chest Society (ICS) that provides practical training for young professionals to conduct high-quality respiratory research. This partnership brought this coveted training programme, which has been running successfully in several low- and middle-income countries for the past 2-3 decades, to India.

The training consists of 3 onsite training levels, each lasting 1 week, over a minimum of 2 years for an individual. Key to the success of the programme are the dedicated faculty, who are experts in research methodology and are well-accomplished researchers themselves, from the United States and India. CMC contributes the maximum number (4 faculty).

The faculty-to-student ratio is 1:2, and mentors provide intensive mentorship throughout the year. Dr D.J. Christopher was instrumental in bringing MECOR to India and serves as the course director. This is the first time it is being hosted at CMC; it had been hosted at St. John's Medical College, Bangalore, for the past 3 years. From the first year, the programme has attracted keen young people from across India and overseas.

This year, 27 students were mentored across three levels of training:

Level 1, held in the Examination Hall Conference Room (2nd Floor, New Exam Hall), focused on training participants to frame a research question and develop a research protocol.

Level 2, conducted at the Biostatistics Research and Training Centre, guided students in converting their research protocol into a detailed Manual of Procedures.

Level 3, hosted in the Pharmacology Computer Lab, trained participants in data analysis and manuscript writing for publication.

This mentorship model enabled focused discussion, critical appraisal, and structured development of the research projects. A distinctive strength of the MECOR programme is that students bring their own original research ideas. Over the three levels, these ideas are progressively transformed — from a well-framed research question into a robust protocol, then into a detailed Manual of Procedures, followed by implementation of the research in the participant's parent institution, culminating in data analysis, manuscript writing, and submission for publication. In the usual course of progression, successful participants advance to the next level each year based on predefined criteria. The programme also incorporates rigorous pre-course and post-course assignments, ensuring that students meet the academic expectations at each level and maintain continuity in their research journey.



The programme was inaugurated with a prayer by Rev. Joseph Devaraj from the Chaplaincy Department. The course directors, Dr. D. J. Christopher from ICS and Dr. Trishul Siddharthan from ATS, provided leadership and shared valuable insights throughout the programme. The final day presentations were attended by Dr. Jacob John, Additional Vice Principal (Research), CMC Vellore, who appreciated the academic rigour and collaborative spirit between the Indian and American thoracic society faculty.

The week was marked by enthusiastic participation, rigorous academic engagement, and meaningful mentorship, making it a rich learning experience for both the students and the faculty.

We express our sincere gratitude to the American Thoracic Society and the Indian Chest Society for entrusting CMC Vellore with hosting this prestigious programme. We also thank the CMC administration for their strong support and encouragement in facilitating this academic venture. We look forward to hosting ATS–ICS MECOR again next year during the same period.

10-year-old boy gets back limbs after 14-hour surgery

A helium cylinder explosion at a local festival caused traumatic amputation and burns below both knees in a 10-year-old boy. The amputated lower limbs were preserved at the scene by first responders, and the child was transported to Christian Medical College Vellore within hours. At the Trauma Centre, CMC Vellore Ranipet Campus, paediatric intensivists and anaesthetists stabilised the patient. A combined team from Plastic Surgery and Paediatric Orthopaedics, led by Dr. Jonathan Victor and Dr. Arul Murugan respectively, undertook a complex 14-hour surgery to reattach both legs. The surgery involved reconstruction of bones, blood vessels, nerves, muscles and skin under the operating microscope.

Both limbs have survived completely. The child has recovered well and was discharged after three weeks of admission. He is expected to regain independent mobility following physiotherapy and rehabilitation. The logistics of this bilateral reimplantation surgery could be done seamlessly because of the teamwork of all those involved. The challenges posed by extremely small blood vessels of sizes ranging from 0.6 to 0.8mm could be surmounted by precise techniques of super microsurgery.

Short course on 'Peritoneal Dialysis' for Nurses

19th January to 15th February, 2026

The departments of Nephrology & Medical Surgical Nursing, Speciality -IX (Nephrology Nursing), along with the Continuing Professional Advancement & Blended Learning Cell, College of Nursing, commenced their 8th batch of the Short Course in Peritoneal Dialysis for Nurses, between the 19th of January and the 15th of February, 2026. 3 nurses from the Tura Christian Hospital, West Garo Hills, Meghalaya, were enrolled in this 4-week onsite training in the peritoneal dialysis unit of CMC Vellore. The course is endorsed by the International Society of Nephrology (ISN), the Peritoneal Dialysis Society of India (PDSI), and the Indian Society of Nephrology. This short course is designed to prepare registered nurses working in Nephrology settings with specialised knowledge, skills, and competence in providing Peritoneal Dialysis (PD) to patients with End Stage Renal Disease. It also aims to equip them to educate, train, and counsel patients and caregivers on various aspects of Peritoneal Dialysis. The nurses, through training, can take up autonomous roles as educators, facilitators, and counsellors, thus functioning as integral members of the Peritoneal Dialysis team. The delegates expressed a high level of satisfaction with the short course and look forward to initiating the Peritoneal dialysis services so that the people of West Garo Hills may benefit.



Essentials in Paediatric Emergency Nursing

February 17th, 2026

The Department of Paediatrics and Paediatric Nursing, along with the Continuing Professional Advancement & Blended Learning Cell, College of Nursing, Christian Medical College Vellore, organised a state-level workshop on 'Essentials in Paediatric Emergency Nursing on February 17th, 2026. The workshop started with an inaugural programme. A total of 53 delegates from within the organisation and across the state participated. Faculty from the Departments of Paediatric Nursing and Paediatrics at CMC Vellore, Scudder Memorial Hospital, Ranipet and Dr. Nesa Sathya Satchi, Chennai, facilitated the sessions. The various topics focused on during the workshop were: assessment of a sick child, airway and ventilation management, circulatory shock, paediatric emergencies, management of bites, stings and golden hour management of an unstable child with poisoning. Skill sessions were conducted focusing on emergency assessment and triage, practical details of airway management, vascular access and drugs used in paediatric emergencies. The delegates expressed a high level of satisfaction with the workshop. The Tamil Nadu Nurses and Midwives Council awarded 7 credit points for the workshop.



First CMC Cerebral Palsy Cadaveric Dissection Workshop

The Department of Paediatric Orthopaedics, along with the Department of Anatomy, conducted the "First CMC Cerebral Palsy Cadaveric Dissection Workshop" on 21st February 2026. The participants included Orthopaedic surgeons from Mission hospitals, Paediatric Orthopaedic consultants and trainees. The course was well received. 
